Its advanced design reflects Kaiser Permanente's integrated approach, incorporating leading-edge technology and enhanced patient amenities to deliver a comfortable, coordinated, high-quality care experience.

The existing hospital will remain fully operational during construction. When the new hospital tower opens in 2029, the current medical center building will be replaced with additional parking, walkways, and outdoor spaces.
